

HIGH ALPHA SUMMIT ATTENDEES **Integrity:** Encompasses the sum total of a person's set of values — his private moral code. A breach of any of these values will damage the individual's integrity. Integrity, closely related to the word integer, refers to a notion of completeness or wholeness.

Over three days, participants learn the fundamentals of serving as chief executive officer for their respective chapter or colony, with emphasis on leadership, ethics, operations management, external relations and harm reduction. The summit features presentations from speakers in the Greek/higher education community, and participants learn and work in small groups with brothers from all over North America. The summit seeks to equip participants with the necessary tools and best practices to improve communication, manage others effectively and to develop efficiency as the chapter leader. While discussing common issues among chapters and colonies, participants gain valuable information on values based leadership and develop their core competencies of communication, problem solving, goal setting and interpersonal skills.
