## REENGINEERING THE MODEL, MODERN FRATERNITY

As the Fraternity and Educational Foundation team up to look ahead into the future, we believe that young men need new and unique opportunities to grow, serve, and lead. As such, in July of 2020, the Educational Foundation set out to raise \$2.4 million of seed money within the next three years. The capital, coupled with endowment earnings and annual donor contributions, will serve as an immediate investment toward repositioning the Lambda Chi Alpha experience in three areas:

**Leadership & Personal Development** - Grow Lambda Chi Alpha leaders

**Educational Curriculum & Delivery** - Equip young men with Lambda Chi Alpha values

**Content-Rich Partnerships** - Promote thought leadership through partnerships

# JULY 2020

## NAVIGATING THE UNKNOWN

With 30% of chapters operating entirely virtually, the Office of Administration and the Educational Foundation teamed up to provide a robust suite of online tools, free of charge (estimated at \$1,600 per chapter), easing the transition to virtual operations, which included:

**OmegaFi:** Financial management platform for chapter billing, budgeting, and forecasting.

**Zoom:** Video conferencing for distance connectivity and learning.

**Chapter Builder:** Customer relations management software to modernize recruitment.



## FUNDING AREAS OF GREATEST NEED



To help provide ongoing support for Fraternity initiatives like the Stead Leadership Seminar and other areas of greatest need, in conjunction with the We Believe Fund, The Circle of Light was created to help current and prospective donors understand the need for their support and appreciate the impact of - and our gratitude for - their giving.

In FY19 and FY20, there were an average of 118 donors who made gifts at the Gold Circle or higher (\$1,000+). Looking ahead, by 2030 and beyond, the Educational Foundation will rely on 1,000 donors to give \$1,000 or more each year.

## DESTINED TO GROW

Because of its virtual format, the 2020 Stead Leadership Seminar was mostly donor-funded. As such, 461 undergraduates and 110 alumni registered for this year's virtual seminar, which offered resources in the areas of recruitment techniques, branding and marketing, skills training, action planning, goal setting, and values alignment. With its renewed focus on growth, the organization ended five years of declining membership and became one of only three fraternities in the country to grow last fall.

## \$300,000 FOR 300,000

In honor of initiating our 300,000th Brother, Ryan Powell (Northern Arizona, '21), the Educational Foundation set out to raise \$300,000—one dollar for every initiated Lambda Chi. Brothers and supporters across the world were challenged to make a unique gift of \$10 for every year since they were initiated into our bond. And many did as 806 donors participated to raise a total of \$374,718! One in five donors gave at the tenfold level, making the 2020 Giving Day Challenge our most successful day of giving to date.



## LEADING THROUGH A PANDEMIC

Lambda Chi Alpha kicked off the new year with the 2021 High Alpha Summit & Neville Advisor's College (HASNAC), which virtually hosted 177 undergraduate and 66 alumni participants. Funded through a grant by the Educational Foundation, HASNAC prepares chapter presidents to serve as CEO of their chapter, emphasizing situational leadership, ethical decision-making, operations management, and strategic planning through goal setting and review. Advisors are simultaneously equipped to support the development of our young men through coaching and mentorship.

## GROWING TOGETHER

The trials of the pandemic continued into the spring semester. Recognizing an ongoing need, the Grand High Zeta authorized \$800,000 to support general operations and chapter growth. A cornerstone of this investment, the Initiation Incentive Program, incentivized recruitment and retention by providing chapters a \$750 credit for every 10% increase in spring membership, up to \$3,000.

# Seed Capital Donor Honor Roll

With gratitude, the Educational Foundation recognizes the following donors who have participated in the ongoing Seed Capital Campaign. By 2023, the Educational Foundation will invest \$2.4 million toward reinventing and reimagining the tools and pathways used by the Fraternity to inspire and equip men to lead an ethical life of growth, service, and leadership: \$1 million in leadership and personal development, \$1 million in educational curriculum and delivery, and another \$400,000 in content-rich partnerships. 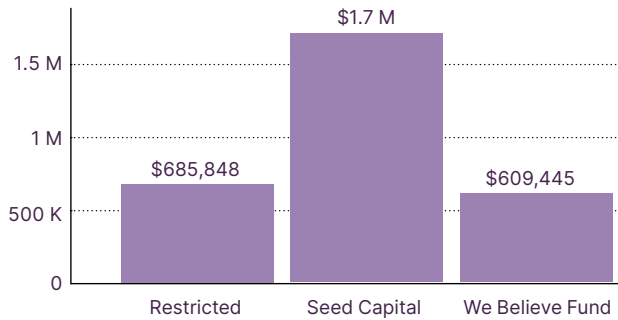
